*Community Summer Employment Project* is a 9-week work summer experience program that assists with various clean-up and maintenance projects aimed at improving the quality of life for core area residents in Brandon.

The program combines classroom training, safety certificates and training, and on-the-job work experience. The summer work experience focuses on beautifying core areas in Brandon.

Participants will also receive employment & training counselling and assistance in developing career goals and action plans; job search strategies; and referrals to further employment or training opportunities.

Participants to start July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019 and the project will end August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Monday - Friday, 37.5 hours a week.

#### **Eligible Participants:**

Metis, Non-Status, or Inuit individuals who:

- Are 15 - 30 years of age
- Currently a student & returning to school in the fall
- Are physically fit & able to work outdoors
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment
